A Word from the Rector...

Sanctuary is a place of safety and protection. The idea comes from the Hebrew Scriptures that describe certain cities in ancient Israel, cities run by the priests, where people could go to escape from those seeking revenge. Through the centuries, Christian Churches have served a similar function where people would be protected from revenge, and in many cases, from civil authority seeking to arrest and detain.

This last Sunday I preached on resistance to the values of the world and on how people of faith might offer sanctuary to those embattled by the world and her authorities. The sermon can be found at the link <http://daytonchristepiscopal.com/sanctuary/>.

Among other things I recalled Pharaoh's call for the death of the Hebrew male children and King Herod's murder of the Holy Innocents of Bethlehem. Similar *sanctuary* movements have been represented in the Underground Railroad, helping slaves escape to the north, and by people of faith who helped Salvadoran refugees escape into Canada.

Just before this past Christmas I was approached by a member of The Living Beatitudes Community asking if I would like to join in displaying —> this banner.

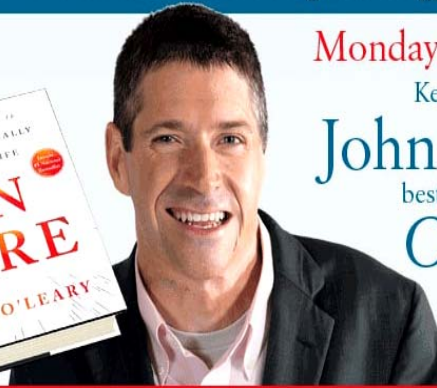

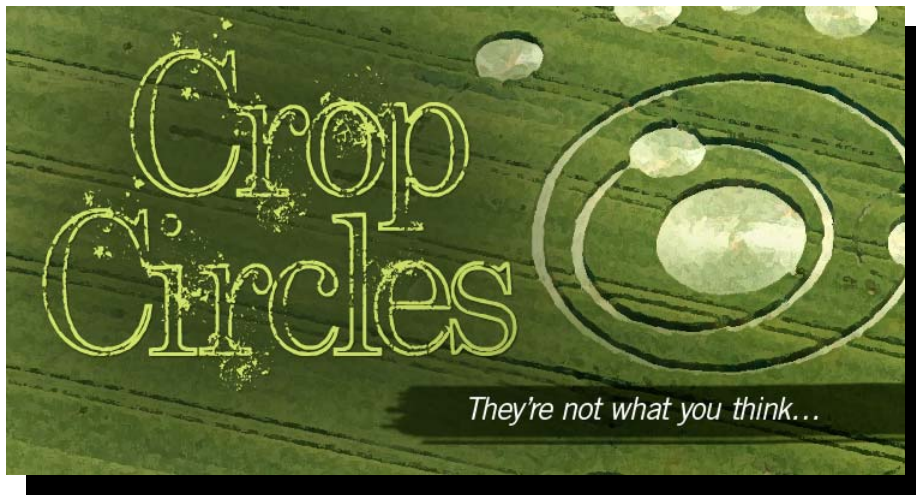
