THE PASSIONS OF THE CHRIST: WHEN IT'S OUR TURN

This year's Lenten Wednesday evening series will intersect with the Sunday Adult Forum series presented by Dr. Larry Welborn, "The Passions of the Christ." On the five Sundays in Lent, Dr. Welborn will follow the tumultuous emotional journey of Jesus during the last week of his life, "by which he broke free of captivity to loss and grief and became the agent of salvation for others."

When we too suffer the loss or grief—the loss of an ideal or a loved one, the crushing of hope—how can we learn from following Jesus on his path through difficult times? As Dr. Welborn offers his insights into Christ's passionate week and how he moved through these passions, on Wednesday evenings we will further explore how Jesus' journey and struggles relate to our own. We will draw upon Sunday's presentations to explore how they give us insights into our own difficult journeys and how we too can be transformed by passions rather than defeated by them.

The Wednesday Lenten program will begin at 6:00pm with a Taizé prayer service in the chapel, followed by a simple soup supper in the parish hall. The program will begin around 7:00pm with a brief summary of the previous Sunday's presentation, a personal story, and then an invitation to discuss your own journeys around the table.
