Civil Conversations in Uncivil Times: Free class available Oct 12-26

Registration is now open for an amazing, free class to help us faithfully prepare for the November elections: **The Big Class: Civil Conversations in Uncivil Times — Practicing Our Faith in the Public Square with Ray Suarez.**

In this contentious election season, many of us are looking for ways to bring our faith into our political interactions. Ray Suarez knows a lot about contentious political landscapes. He also knows a great deal about faith. As an award-winning journalist (PBS Newshour, NPR, Al Jazeera), college instructor, and outspoken Episcopalian, he has **written a book on the subject of faith and politics in the United States.**

You can take this course at your own pace, at whatever time suits you. It should take less than an hour to complete, and students will have an opportunity to ask the instructor questions.
