First Reading: Wisdom 6:12-19

¹²Luminous and unfading is Wisdom, and easily discerned by those who love her, and found by those who seek her. ¹³She anticipates those who desire her, to make herself known in advance. ¹⁴The one who rises early to seek her will not grow weary, and will find her sitting at the gate. ¹⁵For to fix one's thought on her is perfect understanding, and the one who remains awake on her account will soon be secure. ¹⁶Those worthy of her she seeks, traveling about, and in their paths she appears to them, graciously, and, in every thought she meets them. ¹⁷For her beginning is the true desire for instruction, and concern for instruction is love of her. ¹⁸Now love of her is keeping her teachings, and attention to her teachings is assurance of immortality. ¹⁹And immortality brings one near to God.

Psalm: Psalm 63:1-8

¹God, my God, I seek you, you, my soul thirsts for you; my flesh hungers for you, as in a dry and weary land without water.

⁴Therefore will I bless you by name as long as I live; while I lift up my hands.
⁵As with a rich feast my soul is satisfied, and with singing lips my mouth will praise you 6when I recall you upon my bed, and in the watches of the night meditate on you—7for you have been my help—

Second Reading: 1 Peter 1:3-9

³Blessed be the God and Father of our Redeemer Jesus Christ who in great mercy has engendered a new birth for us into a living hope, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, ⁴into an inheritance that is incorruptible, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you all, ⁵who in the power of God are kept through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the end time. ⁶In this you rejoice even when necessary for you to suffer various trials, ⁷in order that the examination of your faith, more precious than gold, which though perishable is tested by fire, may be found yielding praise and glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed. ⁸You have not seen him, yet you love him. You do not see him now, yet you believe in him and rejoice with a joy glorious and beyond words. ⁹You are receiving the completion of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

Gospel: John 11:17-27

¹⁷When Jesus arrived [in Bethany], he found that for four days Lazarus had already been in the tomb. ¹⁸Now Bethany was near Jerusalem, about two miles away. ¹⁹So, many of the Judeans had come to Martha and Mary to console them about their brother. ²⁰When Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she met him, however Mary remained at the house. ²¹Martha said to Jesus, "Rabbi, if you had been here, my brother would never have died. ²²Yet even now I know that whatever you ask of God, God will give you." ²³Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise." ²⁴Martha said to him, "I know that he will rise in the resurrection on the last day." ²⁵Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me, even though they die, they will live, ²⁶and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" ²⁷She said to him, "Yes, Rabbi, I believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who comes into the world."
